The main research topics concern different aspects of cultures of product and process design and 'humanities centred innovation', principally:

- Design for the Cultural Heritage system, dealing with cultural intensive and performative artifacts, local and territorial development, intangible cultural heritage, arts and craft and smart technologies for museums and cultural institutions.
- cultures of design research and scientific publishing, dealing with a pluriversal approach for decentering the scientific and academic design knowledge and narratives.

These themes are amply **applied in the institutional teaching activity** within the Degree in Product Design and Product Design Innovation of the **School of Design and the PhD in Design at the Politecnico di Milano**, within the **extra-curricular didactic** (masters, workshops, summer schools) and in the **visiting professorship abroad**.

The themes are also investigated through the participation to several international and national funded research projects and divulgated through the scientific production of publications, conferences and seminars.
